

FACELESS DOLL HOSPITAL GOWN

Supplies: 1 Fat Quarter 1 Pkg Each of $\frac{1}{4}$ " & $\frac{1}{2}$ " Double
Thread to match Folded Bias Tape

You will need to cut out one back piece, two front panels, two front plaque pieces (can be $\frac{1}{2}$ " Double Folded Bias Tape) and one piece of $\frac{1}{4}$ " double folded bias tape - cut to 22 $\frac{1}{2}$ ". If you have them, use pinking shears to cut out the gown pieces (especially across the shoulder area and down the sides as they are the only areas that stay open), then you won't have to serge the seams to keep them from raveling.

Fold the plaque pieces to the center and iron flat (if using fabric scraps). Place them on each front piece and stitch down. Next stitch the shoulder seams, iron flat, and then fold the sleeves twice to hem them and stitch down.

Next you will stitch the underarm area on both sides, turn the bottom hem up twice $\frac{3}{8}$ " and stitch. Take your 22 $\frac{1}{2}$ " piece of bias tape and fold the ends in, find the center of the tape and place it on the center back fold, pin around to the front plaque and stitch.

The gown is now complete. Let's try to make them each a little different like the pillowcases and mix and match the fabrics. We could even do a little embroidery if you have the time.

I have found that they don't take to long to make, if you have all of the pieces precut. The hardest part is the $\frac{1}{4}$ " bias tape.
