

How to Get the Most Out of a Seminar or Class!!

1. If the Class is not your local Area Group, call the Area Rep for permission as some have limited room.
2. Get the required supplies before coming to class.
3. Clean and stitch out your machine at home prior to class. Wind extra Sew-Bob or invisible thread on bobbins at home.
4. Be in place and set up in classroom ahead of time.
5. Have extra fees or checks made out ahead of time for class or kit fees.
6. Give teacher your UNDIVIDED attention. Do not interrupt or voice your opinion or experiences. Others have paid to get that teacher's method, not yours.
7. Avoid visiting or conversation during class time. If you must say anything to your neighbor, please whisper. Let the teacher do the talking and students do the listening. If there is a break time provided and others are still in class, PLEASE keep your voice low.
8. Students interrupting may change the teachers line of thought and everyone could miss an important point or technique. Let the teacher teach!
9. All questions should be directed to the teacher for an answer as her methods may be different from your neighbors, and the neighbors' method may make other steps difficult down the line.
10. Space is generally limited so be very considerate of your neighbor.
11. If you must leave the room, or leave early, do so as quietly as possible.
12. Leave your work area neater than you found it!!! Your Mother will not be there to pick up after you.
13. Do Not go into another classroom anytime during class time even if the teacher is not talking!!!

All of these hints will enable you and others to get the most out of the class or seminar. It will be a very productive learning experience for everyone.
