**SEMINAR 2008  
GIFT EXCHANGE  
WATER BOTTLE TOTE**

**Minimum Requirements**

**1. Must have a pocket,  
5.5" x 4" approximate size.**

**2. Pocket must be  
decorated with a  
Free motion Technique**

**3. Must be insulated  
and lined.**

**Fits up to 32 oz. bottles.**

**Material List:**

**¼ yard Fashion Fabric**

**¼ yard Lining Fabric**

**¼ yard Insulating Fabric**

**such as Insul-Brite**

**Bias Tape for binding handles**

**Cut one each of the fashion and lining fabric and of the insulating material.**

**Cut material for pocket 12" X 4.5" and fold in half for a 6" deep pocket.**

**You will sew tucks in the bottom of the pocket to create ease  
within the pocket. Pattern included ½" seam allowance.**

**Decorate the pocket and stitch it in place before you stitch up the sides.  
Fold right sides together and stitch. Turn to right side out. This makes a  
tube with a handle. Lay the insulating fabric on the wrong side  
of the lining fabric and fold over with right side of lining fabric together.**

**Stitch down both sides, making second tube. Trim away the  
excess bulk from the seam allowance on the insulating fabric.**

**Square up the bottom of both tubes, using the common square  
corner method. Work lining tube into the first tube made  
from the fashion fabric. Carefully seat the two bottoms together.**

**Bind the handle section using Bias Tape.**
